The DiverSeedPaths project is proud to invite you to an online capacity-building session on European Seed Policy and Legislation which will take place **online on Thursday, 17 October 2024 14:00-18:00 and Friday, 18 October 2024 09:30-13:30 (CET)**.

This session led by the **European Coordination Let's Liberate Diversity's member, Arche Noah**, will cover a review of the legislation on seed marketing within the EU and the latest updates and changes in EU seed marketing regulations.

The aim of the session is to provide cultivated plant diversity actors and peasant organisations with information on the current state of the **political process**, and to **foster effective action and collaboration** by these actors to advocate for a regulation that protects and promotes diversity and the implementation of the right to food and the right to seeds recognised in the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Peasants and Other People Working in Rural Areas (UNDROP).

The workshop will entail a mixture of presentations and discussions in plenary and break-out groups. **There will be translation provided from English to French and German.**
